## Understanding the Social and Emotional Aspects of Learning (SEAL)

Emotions are especially important in influencing not only how we behave but also how we learn. For many years, a focus on emotions was seriously neglected in the way we were advised to work with children. The recent roll-out of DCSF SEAL materials in primary settings started to redress that balance. The launch in the autumn of SEAL in secondary schools is another step forward, likely to benefit all children, but particularly those with social, emotional and behavioural barriers to learning.

This is another chance to attend a SEBDA day with Adrian Faupel. The content is primarily designed for teachers and TAs in secondary, primary and special schools (and PRUs). It is also highly relevant for youth, mental health social or residential care workers.
