Parent Support Adviser /Learning Mentor Training.

Staff appointed to these roles will have a wide base of experience. That is, in many ways the most exciting part of this role in Cornwall. It provides the Extended Services, including schools, to work on supporting school improvement and in particular Swift and Easy Access to support local needs.

The training for parent support Advisers and Learning mentors are very similar. Therefore we are combining the training of these staff with the Common Induction training to ensure all are aware of the key principles for

- Principles, Values and legislation
- Understanding children and young people's development
- Building relationships and communicating with children, young people and families
- Keeping children and young people safe from harm
- Integrated working

These days take up to **four days of training events** and some workplace based activity. These modules are generic to the training for all CYP staff, including staff in school and our extended services settings.

The **role specific training** in Cornwall will examine

- Facilitating children and young people's development through mentoring. Topics covered include barriers to learning and participation, identifying learning strengths and structured approaches to mentoring.
- Parent support Advisers – group work and national practice case examples of working.
- Family Learning, Problem solving with children and families, supporting transitions, supporting attendance, supporting improved behaviour.

These days will take place over a **2 day period**.

We would expect all staff, appointed with this Extended Services funding, regardless of experience to do as a **minimum the two day role specific training**. This would occur within six months of appointment. In addition, all staff will be expected to attend CAF training.

Strengths, Difficulties Questionnaires (SDQ)

It can be used by teachers, parents, children and young people & their practitioners to clarify perceptions of strengths and problems.
